
MBX BOOSTER CAMP INSTRUCTIONS & FAQs

REGISTER A CAMP

- Complete the **MBX Booster Camp Registration Google Form** including all details to be provided by parents in the camp sign-up form.
 - Include contact information for the Booster individual who will run the camp and interface with MBX staff regarding camp and enrollment questions.
 - Provide a graphic for use on 6crickets to advertise the camp. A digital image must have an aspect ratio of 3:2 (width:height) and be at least 1200 pixels wide. A standard MBX Booster Camp image will be used if an image is not provided or if the correct format is not submitted.

CAMP REVENUE

- 6crickets revenue and related fees are recorded in your GL at the time the funds are deposited into the bank, not at the time of the camp.
 - All revenues related to camps are recorded in account 330-Fundraising, unless specified otherwise, and the fees are recorded in account 585-Processing Fees.

MANAGING ENROLLMENT

- If camp begins on a Monday, consider having cancellation terms stating that there will be no refunds after 3pm on Friday. Please be mindful that MBX staff cannot always be available throughout weekends and holidays leading up to your camp start time. MBX staff will address all changes within 24 hours of your camp start time.
 - Submit discount code requests prior to your registration open date.
 - Boosters are responsible for running their own rosters for camps. All names provided on the MBX Booster Camp Registration Form will have the ability to view and run rosters.
 - Waivers must be signed for all participants. If parents want to register at the time of camp have them log into 6crickets and enroll their child in the camp. If that is not possible please ensure you have paper copies of the waiver and accept payment in cash or check (made payable to MBX). Venmo and other cash pay apps may not be accepted.
