

HOW DOES MBX SUPPORT BOOSTER CLUBS?

Booster Support

- Provides support and officer training
- Registers as a charitable organization yearly allowing Boosters non-profit status
- Reviews and submits ASK and SCO agreements to MBUSD and school board for discussion and approval
- Sets up the Booster ASK
- Promotes merchandise sales and fundraisers via MBUSD channels
- Designs and distributes the MBX Newsletter and manages MBX social media promotion
- Updates booster website pages on mbxfoundation.org
- Holds SCO meetings

Financial Support

- Oversees banking accounts and transactions
- Provides insurance for camps, fundraisers, summer athletics, VAPA programs and banquets
- Manages the camp registration system
- Manages online payment systems
- Conducts monthly reconciliations and yearly audits
- Facilitates the setup and launch of Square stores for sales

Facilities Support

- Plans, funds and purchases CapEx (Capital Expenditure) projects
- Upgrades and maintains fields and facilities

2026-2027 MBX BOOSTER FEES

SCO Administration Fee - \$250 per SCO annually

- This base fee provides your SCO with comprehensive administrative and financial support throughout the school year. It also includes the setup and management of up to two camps held during the school year.
- Note: This fee will be deducted from your account once your budget has been approved.

Camp Management Fee

- \$150 per additional school year camp - This fee applies to every camp run during the school year beyond the initial two included in the SCO Administrative Fee.
- \$200 per summer camp - This fee applies to every summer camp to help offset the higher facility costs the district charges MBX during the summer months.
- Note: These fees are incurred at the time of scheduling and remain applicable even in the event of a cancellation.

Returned Check Fee - \$25 per occurrence
