### **TYPES OF CLASSES OFFERED:**

### **Traditional In-Person**

- 8:30am-2pm with two breaks
- Traditional class size (approx. 1:30)
- Minimum of 15 students. Classes will be canceled on May 10, 2024 if minimum is not reached.
- \$400 per semester / Health
- \$800 for 2 semester / yearlong\* (Geometry, Modern World History, US History)
- \* \$850 for Chemistry which includes lab fees
- \* \$1050 for Art which includes art supplies

### **Small Group In-Person**

- During enrollment you may request students to be in the same small group
- Minimum of 4 students. Classes will be canceled on May 10, 2024 if minimum is not reached.
- 2 Hour in-person sessions plus 3 or more hours of asynchronous learning. Times listed on the Summer School drop-down under Academic Course Offerings (Geometry, Pre Calculus, US History)
- \$1900 for 2 semester / yearlong
- 3 Hour in-person sessions plus 2 or more hours of asynchronous learning. Times listed on the Summer School drop-down under Academic Course Offerings (Chemistry, Biology)
- \$2850 for 2 semester / yearlong

# **Online Learning / Asynchronous Self-paced**

- \$800 for 2 semester / yearlong\*
