



How do you become a Booster Club?

- MBX Foundation is recognized as a 501(c)3 organization and sponsors all School Connected Organizations (SCOs), also known as Booster Clubs.
- Every organization must apply each year to run a Booster Club (41 clubs).
- This process includes attending mandatory SCO and financial training with your Board and submitting an application which includes your Board Members, budget, ASK letter, etc.
- Once approved by MBX, your proposal goes to the Superintendent and School Board for approval.
- Booster Clubs are required to keep no more than 20% of their operative budget in reserve.
