

# MBX FOUNDATION 2026-2027 COMPLIANCE AGREEMENT

To ensure organizational consistency and maintain our legal standing, all SCOs are required to acknowledge and adhere to the following MBX Foundation protocols:

## 1. Membership

Membership shall be open to all parents and guardians of students who are participants in the SCO. A financial donation is encouraged, but is not a requirement for membership in this organization. If a student resigns or is removed from the team or activity, the parent or guardian will no longer be considered a member of the organization.

## 2. SCO Officers

The SCO will be governed by a Board of Directors (The Board). All members of the Board must be members in good standing with students currently active in the program. The Booster Board must consist of at least two Officers, a President and a Treasurer, who are selected and approved by the outgoing Board.

## 3. SCO Mandatory Training

Our President(s) AND Treasurer(s) have attended both the mandatory SCO AND financial training sessions conducted by the MBX Foundation.

## 4. Email Communications

We have established generic Booster email accounts for both the Booster President and the Treasurer and agree to use these specific accounts for all official Booster club communications to ensure a seamless transition of records between leadership teams.

## 5. Payment Methods

We understand that Booster Clubs are strictly prohibited from using Venmo or other unapproved third-party payment platforms for collecting funds or conducting business.

## 6. MBX Booster Club Fees

We have reviewed the MBX Booster Club Information Sheet and agree to the MBX fee structure.

## 7. Fundraising Guidelines

We have read and fully understand the MBX Fundraising Guidelines and agree to conduct all fundraising efforts in accordance with these standards.

## 8. Raffle Guidelines

We have read and understand the California State Raffle Guidelines provided by MBX Foundation. We agree to conduct our Booster Club's raffle(s) in strict accordance with these rules and recognize that failure to comply may jeopardize the standing of our Booster Club and the 501(c)(3) non-profit status of the MBX Foundation.
